Tournament Format

This golf tournament will be run as a four-player scramble. Team prize divisions will include low net and low gross. To qualify for the net score division, a team’s handicap must be 49 or higher with no more than one single-digit handicap player. Teams with a handicap less than 49 or without verifiable SCGA/NCGA August Indexes will play for gross score.

Registration is limited to a field of 120 golfers, so register early! All hole-in-one prizes are secured through an insurance policy purchased by the Allan Hancock College Foundation. Payout of the \$1,000,000 hole-in-one prize shall be made as an annuity. To be eligible for hole-in-one prizes, the contestant must provide proof of their amateur status.

Bulldog \$1,000,000 “Hole-in-One” ShootOut

Win \$1,000,000! One shot is all it will take for you to go home with a million dollars in your golf bag—but first you’ll have to enter our tournament! This year’s tee marker will be placed at 135 yards from the flag—30 yards closer than last year’s shot.

The “ShootOut” will take place immediately at the conclusion of regular tournament play at the clubhouse as our gallery of golfers enjoys the post-tournament reception. Winners of six separate events taking place during the tournament, including a random draw of names from the pool of all tournament registrants, will determine who will participate in the “ShootOut.” In addition, selected tournament sponsorships (see Sponsor Opportunities) include one guaranteed entry in to the “ShootOut.”

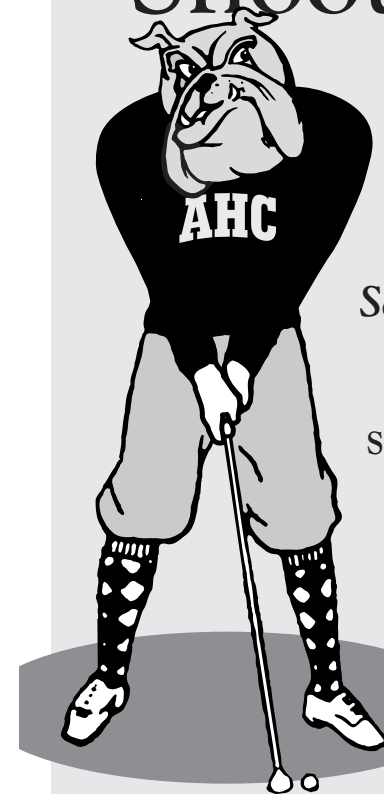
